Students are required to be in attendance on exam days for those periods unless a parent calls in to excuse the student. Students are to remain in the classroom for the entire exam period. Lunch will be available to students and staff each day as listed.

Senior students who met/exceeded on the '07 Spring PSAE in Reading and Math are exempt from the three days of exams. Students in this category would have received a certificate earlier this year.
