Meeting Convened

The Board of Education of School District No. 172, Adams County, Illinois, met in regular session on May 22, 2024 at 6:00 p.m. in the Board of Education Office, Room 214, 1416 Maine Street, Quincy, Illinois, in said school district.

Roll Call

The meeting was called to order by President Arns, who directed the secretary to call the roll. On the call of the roll, the following members were present and answered to their names: Members Ali, Arns, Brock, McNay, Petty, Sethaler, and Whitfield; and the following members were absent: None. Whereupon the President declared a quorum was present.

Moment of Silence

President Arns declared a moment of silence and reflection.

Pledge of Allegiance

The Pledge of Allegiance was led by Member Whitfield.

Questions and Comments

President Arns opened the meeting to questions and comments of members of the Board, by members of the public.

Kathleen Helsabeck, Director of Quincy Public Library, thanked QPS for the partnership with Quincy Public Library. She also shared that because of a grant from Arts Quincy, all of our first graders were able to tour the library.

Reports of the Superintendent

The Super's 8 Highlights

- 1. Lincoln-Douglas students were treated to a Garden Party thanks to a Dream Big Grant. Students decorated garden rocks, planted flowers and learned about soil quality.
- 2. Rooney students held their second annual Rooney Biz Town where 5th graders created businesses from the ground up for the whole school to enjoy. Each student got 50 "Biz Town Bucks" to spend on food, activities and games.
- 3. On Thursday, May 23, Iles students will be hosting an art show featuring student pieces for sale. Proceeds will go to Mr. Brown's Children's Education Fund in memory of Iles teacher Dave Brown who passed away this year.
- 4. The Early Childhood and Family Center celebrated their end of year carnival at South Park. Families were invited to lunch and games including sack races, a bounce house and shaved ice.
- 5. QHS Art Teachers Lexi Brumbaugh and Paige Cummins were nominated and selected to win the Award of Meritorious Service at the ISBE Those Who Excel and Teacher of the Year Banquet.
- 6. The Golden K Kiwanis visited each of the five elementary schools this month for their annual Golden Deeds luncheon honoring 5th grade student leaders and one staff member.
- 7. The QHS drama department put on its spring play, "Deceiving Granny" to rave reviews.
- 8. QJHS 8th graders in Mr. Baker's class reproduced NASA's Double Asteroid Redirection Test where they tried to save Earth (a solo cup) from a deadly asteroid (a basketball). The jury is still out on whether these Comets are Earth's last hope.

He also thanked the Lincoln-Douglas PTO for fundraising so they can purchase additional swings for the playground.

Principal Funkenbusch shared a Power Point spotlighting some of their school year activities:

• Thanks to the Masonic High 12 Club for sponsoring the CAF Rise Above and giving students the opportunity to see the Tuskegee Airmen exhibit in honor of their school's namesake, Colonel George Iles.

- Iles students scored above the 50th percentile for growth on all MAP tests
- Thanks to Trudy Gay for implementing the Intramural Basketball and Cheerleading at Iles. This program aims to teach kids the fundamentals of basketball and cheerleading while building skills and team spirit.
- A penny drive raised \$4,000 to honor our educator and colleague Dave Brown with proceeds going to Mr. Brown's Children's Education Fund. The 5th grade students created a butterfly observation garden as a memorial to Mr. Brown and also a living classroom.
- Iles Art Fair today, May 23 from 3:45-5:30pm with all proceeds going to Mr. Brown's Children's Education Fund.

New QJHS and QHS Assistant Principals

Superintendent Pettit introduced and welcomed Caitlin Munguia as the new QJHS assistant principal and Megan Williams as the new QHS assistant principal.

Building Committee

Chairperson McNay shared that the new HVAC system is being installed in E building at QHS and the plan is to have that wrapped up by the start of the school year. Central Services renovations are coming along. The Transportation Department has been moving into their side of the building; Maintenance Department plans to be moved in by the first part of August; Technology Department hopes to be in by mid-September. The committee also received a handout with the design for the turf and track updates at Flinn. Mr. McNay also updated the Board with information from a meeting with TMI regarding continuing HVAC concerns. TMI has done some analysis to try to pinpoint what is causing problems in the systems.

District Improvement Committee

The District Improvement Committee did not meet in May.

Finance Committee

The committee reviewed the monthly financial update, cash flow summary, and check registers. Chief of Business Operations, Ryan Whicker, shared information regarding the solicited fuel bids for the 2024-2025 school year. Bids were requested for both a "Firm Bid Price" and an "Escalating Bid Price". The district received five escalating bids and five firm bids. It was recommended that the district accept the low escalating bid from Niemann Foods, Inc. Mr. Whicker also shared the recommendation from Jean Kinder, Food Services Director, to increase meal prices \$0.10. The recommended increase will bring the 2024-2025 lunch prices to \$2.95 for pre-K through fifth grade, \$3.20 for grades six through twelve, and \$3.70 for adults. Mr. Whicker shared that the committee also reviewed the amended budget.

Motor Fuel Bids

It was moved by Member Ali and seconded by Member McNay to approve the escalating bid for motor fuel as submitted by Niemann Foods, Inc. for a total estimated market price of

\$253,747.50 (Doc. Reg. No. 3871.) On the call of the roll, the following members voted Aye: Members Ali, Arns, Brock, McNay, Petty, Sethaler, and Whitfield; and the following members voted Nay: None; and the following members were absent: None. Whereupon the President declared the motion carried.

Increase Meal Prices

It was moved by Member Ali and seconded by Member Petty to approve increasing student lunch prices by ten cents. The 2024-2025 lunch prices will be \$2.95 for kindergarten through fifth grade and \$3.20 for grades six through twelve. The new adult meal price for 2024-2025 will be \$3.70.
