SEMESTER FINAL PREP

Semester Finals occur during the last three days of every semester, and semester finals are worth 10% of a student's grade in each class. A few hints in prepping for these exams:

- Most teachers provide study guides in advance. These are an important tool, and will list the knowledge and skills the students need to do well on their exams.
- Cramming can actually work in reverse: A last minute, marathon study session lasting all night can actually be harmful. It is better to spread this out over multiple days and break the time into smaller chunks.
- While studying, take frequent, short brain breaks (3-5 minutes). Get up and move. Listen to a song. Do something that you enjoy but does not take a lot of thinking.
- Find what works for you. There are many techniques that are effective, but what works for one person may not work for all. Here is a valuable online tool:
