- 3. The applicant must be a Adams County Farm Bureau member or dependent of a member at the time of application.

Funds can be requested for a wide range of educational needs, from tuition and fees to books, tools, lab equipment and more. Applications must be submitted **by 4:00 p.m. March 11th , 2025, ALONG WITH A DIGITAL HEADSHOT OF THE APPLICANT** (to be used in promotional material).
